

B20 Brasil Summit: Registrations are now open

The G20 private sector forum will meet in São Paulo in October to discuss recommendations from seven task forces and one action council.

As the main private sector forum of the G20, B20 Brasil has just announced the opening of pre-registrations for its summit, an emblematic event that will bring together representatives from companies and governments to present and discuss recommendations from its secretariat, derived from seven task forces and one action council. With free registration, B20 Brasil's summit is open to the public and will be held in São Paulo on October 24th and 25th. Interested participants can register starting from July 29th on the B20 Summit Brasil website.

The B20 Summit Brasil 2024 will gather secretariat leaders, with speakers and the presence of Brazilian and G20 member country guests. During the two-day event, the expectation is to welcome over a thousand people interested in discussing key issues of Brazil's G20 presidency, such as combating hunger and poverty, and promoting a just energy transition. The full event schedule will be available soon on the official plenary website.

For B20 Chair, Dan Ioschpe, the meeting is an important opportunity to unite business leaders from around the world, with the aim of contributing to global socioeconomic development. "We worked with the chairs of our eight task forces throughout the year, involving more than a thousand people and several institutions around the world, to deliver recommendations to G20 leaders, aiming to pursue sustainable growth, reducing hunger, poverty and inequality, considering a fair and inclusive energy transition. The B20 forum has the potential to influence global policies and generate a positive impact on society", points out Ioschpe.

Presided over by the CNI (National Confederation of Industry), B20 Brasil will host key figures who helped advance the first Brazilian presidency of the forum. Ricardo Alban, CNI President, along with Dan Ioschpe, Chair of B20 Brasil, and Sherpa Constanza Negri, will be the hosts of the summit, which will also feature eight Brazilian CEOs, leaders of the task forces of the secretariat: Ricardo Mussa (Raízen), Francisco Gomes Neto (Embraer), Gilberto Tomazoni (JBS), Paula Bellizia (Ebanx), Luciana Ribeiro (eB, Capital), Walter Schalka (Suzano), Fernando de Rizzo (Tupy), and Claudia Sender, an executive on the board of multinational companies.

The B20 Brasil national and international advisory council will also be present at the summit. Notable names such as Luiza Trajano (Magalu), Christian Gebara (Vivo), Pedro Passos (Natura), Tânia Consentino (Microsoft Brazil), Isaac Sidney (Febraban), Michael R. Bloomberg (Bloomberg), and Michael Miebach (Mastercard) are expected to attend one of the two event days.

The B20 Summit Brasil will be held at Clube Monte Líbano in São Paulo, sponsored by SABIC, ARAMCO, JBS, VRIO, EQUINOR, and BRF-MARFRIG.

The B20 is a global dialogue forum that connects the business community with G20 governments, mobilizing nearly a thousand representatives from the private sector of member countries. The Brazilian edition includes seven task forces and one action council. The working groups consist of Brazilian and international business leaders who have been discussing urgent and important topics since the beginning of the year, including: Trade and Investment, Finance and Infrastructure, Employment and Education, Energy Transition and Climate, Digital Transformation, Integrity and Compliance, Sustainable Food Systems and Agriculture, in addition to the Action Council on Women, Diversity, and Inclusion in Business.
